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## Nuclear Waste Partnership Announces Scholarship Recipients

CARLSBAD, N.M., May 23, 2016 – Nuclear Waste Partnership LLC (NWP) continued it commitment to education with the recent award of \$10,000 in scholarships to high school seniors in southeastern New Mexico.

WIPP, the nation's first permanent geologic repository for defense transuranic nuclear waste, began disposal operations in 1999. NWP is an AECOM-led partnership with Babcock & Wilcox and AREVA.
